Vendors must provide own tables, chairs and tents. Vendors may set up Friday, Saturday: 7-9 AM, Sunday: 7-10 AM. Cherry Street will be blocked off for vendor parking. Vehicles are to park on the North side of the courthouse, Cherry Street. NO PARKING on West side of 2nd Street; however, if vendor location is along 2nd Street you may park on the East side of 2nd Street. We provide two overnight security guards, and the area is patrolled by local law enforcement. Vendors assume all overnight theft risks.
