

DETAILS: 56th Annual Christmas Tree Lane 2024



“Christmas at the Movies” is the theme for this year’s **Christmas Tree Lane**. You can use any movies of the season to inspire your tree decorations.

Tree decorating begins Monday, November 4 and is open to all groups, organizations, families, classrooms, churches and businesses. There is no charge. Trees are provided by ICHS. Bring your own decorations and lights. Please do not use glitter or food products in your decorations. Trees must be decorated by Wednesday, November 27.

There will also be a **Christmas House Gallery** this year. ** NEW FOR 2024 -- There will be separate categories for Christmas houses made from Gingerbread and Christmas houses made from any other medium. ** You can use the theme or choose one of your own. The only restriction is that it must fit into the display case. Houses should be brought to the Museum by 4 p.m. on Thursday, November 28.

Do not delay in selecting your tree. There are trees on the main and upper floors. You can stop by the museum during office hours or call to reserve your tree. The registration form for trees and houses is available from the museum website. If you cannot make it to the museum to choose a tree, we can do that for you, but be sure to complete the registration form, and let us know you want a tree.

For the People’s Choice Award, all trees and houses will be voted on with cash by museum visitors during regular business hours through Monday, December 23 at 4:00 p.m.

** All trees will be entered in Best Decorated and People’s Choice. Each participant then chooses to be entered in 1 of the other 3 categories: Best Hand-Crafted Ornaments, Most Original, or Best Use of Theme. **

Visitors to Christmas Tree Lane and House Gallery will vote on People’s Choice. A panel of judges will be choosing winners in the categories of BEST DECORATED, BEST USE OF YOUR THEME, MOST ORIGINAL and BEST HAND-CRAFTED DECORATIONS. The Houses will be judged on MOST ORIGINAL and BEST DECORATED DISPLAY.

- ♦ Monday, November 4 – Decorating begins. 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. Decorating continues through Wednesday, November 27, 4:00 p.m.
- ♦ Sunday, November 24 – Museum will be open special hours for decorating, 1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.
- ♦ Wednesday, November 27 – Houses must be in place and tree decorating ends at 4:00 p.m.
- ♦ November 28-29 – Museum closed for Thanksgiving Holiday.
- ♦ Sunday, December 1 – Christmas Tree Lane Open House, 1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. Come to view two floors of beauty, and enjoy holiday music throughout the courthouse. Voting begins.
- ♦ Sunday, December 1 – Monday, December 23 – Viewing and voting continue during regular hours, Monday – Friday, 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. Museum will be closed December 24-25.
- ♦ Sunday, December 15 – Museum will be open 1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. for viewing and voting.
- ♦ Monday, December 23 – Voting ends at 4:00 p.m.
- ♦ Thursday, December 26 – Museum will be open 1:00 – 4:00 p.m. for viewing the trees and houses. Museum is closed December 27 – January 1, 2025.
